

## THOMAS D. LEDDY







Thomas D. Leddy, of Shirley (formerly of Farmingdale), passed away suddenly on January 3, 2008. He was the Son of Peter and the late Kathleen. Brother of Anita (Robert) Nigro, Diane (Jim) Notti-Juergens, Peter, John (Yolanda) and the late Christopher. He was also the Uncle of Michael, Matthew, Jacqueline, Russell and Katherine.

Mr. Leddy was a U.S. Army Vietnam Combat Veteran, recipient of the National Defense Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal and Purple Heart, and a Disabled American Veteran.

Thomas was attached from an element of the 17<sup>th</sup> Artillery to the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, (Mechanized) 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry, "D" Company, as the RTO (Radio Telephone Operator) for the Artillery Forward Observer and was severely wounded in March of 1968 during the Battle of LZ Litts in Binh Dinh Province on the Bong Son Coastal Plains of Central Vietnam. He is fondly remembered by Bob Gold, Russ Roth, and all of his fellow "Delta Company" brothers.

Arrangements were made by Arthur F. White Funeral Home. Funeral Mass was held January 7 at St. Martin of Tours RC Church with interment following at Calverton National Cemetery.
