We have determined that Clifton Baldwin was not a member of the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion (M), 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry during our tour in Vietnam.

We currently do not have access to the information that reported him as one of our KIAs, but it was indicated in a note on our original "In Memoriam" pages that someone within our Association identified him as such.

The "Cause of Death" is listed as "Accidental Homicide". This could mean he was run over by a vehicle or shot accidentally by a weapon (Being cleaned?).

Clifton's name is inscribed on our 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry Vietnam Memorial in front of Battalion Headquarters, Treadwell Barracks, Sand Hill, Fort Benning, Georgia. His name will remain on our memorial.
