We have determined that Gregory Dodge was not a member of the 1st Battalion (Mechanized), 50th Infantry in Vietnam. We currently do not have access to the information that reported him as one of our KIAs, but it was indicated in a note on our original "In Memoriam" pages that someone within our Association identified him as such. It could be that he was with our unit for his Basic or Advanced Infantry Training before moving on to his unit in Vietnam ...we do not know. Gregory Dodge's name is inscribed on our 50th Infantry Vietnam Memorial in front of Battalion Headquarters, Fort Benning, Georgia. Our Association has voted unanimously that his name should remain on our memorial. Currently, no photo exists for this man.
