We have determined that Ken Johnson was not a member of the 1st Battalion (M), 50th Infantry during our tour in Vietnam.

We currently do not have access to the information that reported him as one of our KIAs, but it was indicated in a note on our original "In Memoriam" pages that someone within our Association identified him as such. It could be that he was with our unit for his Basic Training before moving on to another unit...we do not know.

Ken's Name was engraved in error on our Memorial at Treadwell Barracks, Fort Benning, GA....current home of the 1st Battalion, 50th Infantry. The name shall not be removed.

Ken is buried at Sunset Lawn Cemetery, El Dorado, KS (Pictured below)
