We have determined that Marvin Murray was not a member of the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion (M), 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry during our tour in Vietnam. We currently do not have access to the information that reported him as one of our KIAs, but it was indicated in a note on our original "In Memoriam" pages that someone within our Association identified him as such. All 50th Infantry Casualties on the date of Murray's death are all accounted for.

Marvin's name is inscribed on our 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry Vietnam Memorial in front of Battalion Headquarters, Fort Benning, Georgia. His name will remain on our memorial.

Marvin Murray is buried at Woodlawn Cemetery, Webster Avenue and East 233rd Street, Bronx, New York (Photo Below).
