We have determined that Larry Trevarton was not a member of the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion (M), 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry during our tour in Vietnam.


Initially, he was listed as a casualty within our battalion but subsequent document gathering proved otherwise. His name was inscribed in error on our 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry Vietnam Memorial in front of Battalion Headquarters, Fort Benning, Georgia. A unanimous vote of our association ruled that his name will remain on our memorial and we will give corrected information here on our web site.

Currently we have no documentation describing the action which took PFC Trevarton's life. If ongoing research reveals any specifics, they will be added here at a future date.
