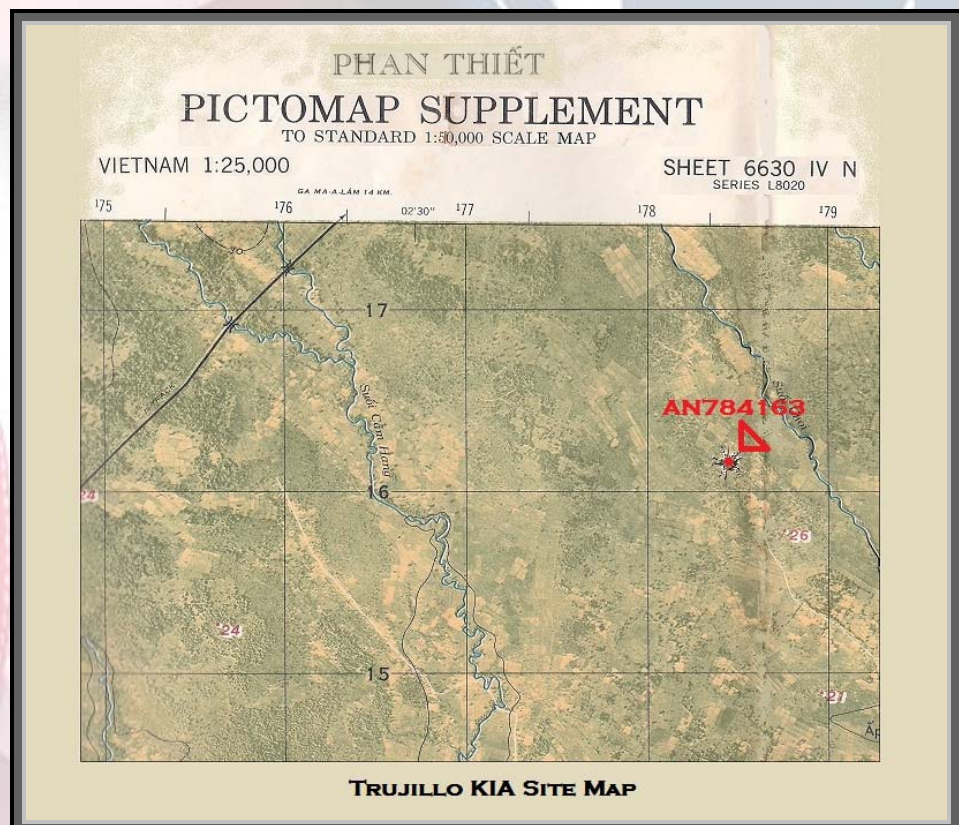

Francisco Trujillo (Photo at right) was killed during a search and destroy mission approximately 8 kilometers Northwest of Phan Thiet City in Binh Thuan Province.

The Daily Staff Journal of 4 December 1969 reads: "Company C, 1st Battalion (Mechanized), 50th Infantry had an APC (Armored Personnel Carrier) hit a Booby Trapped White Phosphorous mortar round at map grid coordinate AN784163 (shown below). There was no damage to the APC, but as the men dismounted the APC, Dennis Shannon tripped a second IED (Report as a High Explosive 82mm Mortar round) killing Trujillo and injuring 4 others.

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Francisco Trujillo is buried at Winton Cemetery, 7643 Almond Avenue, Winton, Merced County, California.
