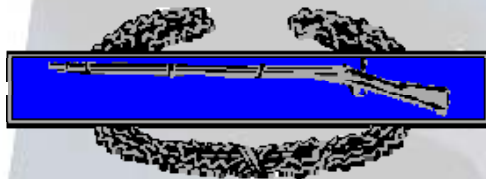




## 1ST BATTALION (MECHANIZED), 50TH INFANTRY
