Mr. Phil Davis Obituary - April 12, 1947 ~ July 17, 2017

Thomson, Georgia - Mr. Phil Davis, 70, went to be with his Lord on July 17, 2017 at his residence.

Mr. Davis was a lifelong resident of McDuffie County, Georgia, the son of the late William Odell Davis and the late Mary Inez Hobbs Davis.
