

Aaron Miles Gage was born February 26, 1939 in Chickasha, OK the son of Johnny and Maple (Rogers) Gage. He passed from this life on December 1, 2023 in Muskogee. He was 84 years of age.



Aaron served in the United States Army for 23 years, retiring in 1977 at the rank of Sergeant Major. He served two tours in Viet Nam. One of those tours in Vietnam was served with the 1st Battalion (Mechanized), 50th Infantry, 173rd Airborne Brigade and Task Force South of the 1st Field Force, Vietnam as an Intelligence and Security NCO (S-2 Headquarters) from October, 1968 through October of 1969.
