

Howard Marcantel joined "A" Company, 1st Battalion (Mechanized), 50th Infantry in June of 1969 at Camp Radcliff in An Khe, Binh Dinh Province, and served as an Armored Personnel Carrier Mechanic. He was with the unit when they moved to LZ Betty near Phan Thiet in Binh Thuan Province, spending time at LZ Panzer. He served into 1970 before finishing his tour.
