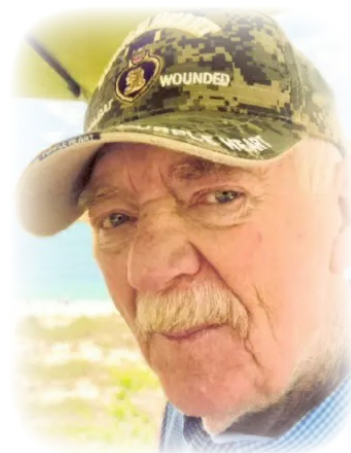


Richard L. Roschy Obituary

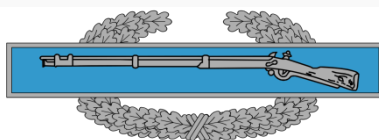
