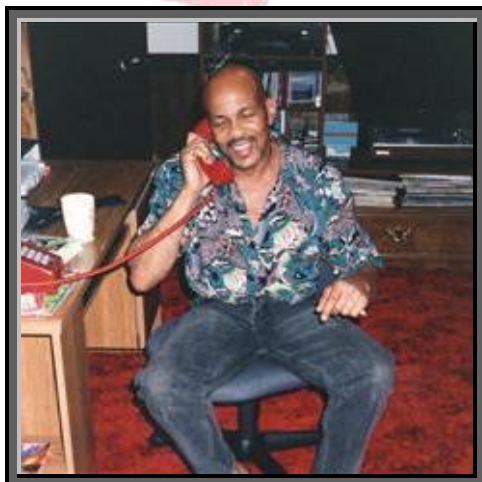


**SPECIALIST WARREN J VALLEAU
