

Gordon T. Wemmitt

BILLERICA -- Gordon T. Wemmitt, 58, a resident of Billerica and a Vietnam War veteran, died Saturday, March 31, 2007, at home, surrounded by his family, after a battle with cancer. He was the loving husband and best friend of Carol (Lattanzi) Wemmitt.

He was born in Glens Falls, N.Y., May 23, 1948, son of the late Gordon and Josephine M. (Doner) Wemmitt. He had lived in New York before moving to Billerica in 1973.

Mr. Wemmitt served in the Army in 1969 with the 1st Battalion (Mechanized), 50th Infantry, 173rd Airborne Brigade during the Vietnam War

Mr. Wemmitt had been employed at USCI Bard in Billerica for 20 years. He also worked for Frank's Heating of Tewksbury, and most recently for the Portland Group in Billerica in inside sales for the past six years.

He was an avid NASCAR fan and had season tickets at New Hampshire International Speedway in Loudon, N.H, where he attended many races. He also attended several other events at tracks across the country.

Besides his wife, he is survived by his beloved children, Gordon Wemmitt and his wife, Jennifer of California, Joseph Wemmitt and Kerri Wemmitt, both of Billerica; a brother, Thomas Wemmitt of North Carolina; two sisters, Alice Hunt of New York, and Betty Abney of North Carolina.
