## **Wilbert C. "Will" Rahiser, Jr.**

November 11, 1944 - January 27, 2007



Wilbert C. (Will) Rahiser Jr., age 62 of West Metzger Avenue, Butler, Pennsylvania, died Saturday, January 27, 2007 at 3:15 p.m. in the Concordia Lutheran Ministries.

Born November 11, 1944 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Wilbert C. Rahiser and the late Margaret Kline Rahiser.

Mr. Rahiser was a teacher of Social Studies for Butler Area School District, retiring in 2000, after 30 years of service. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the Vietnam War. Mr. Rahiser was a member of the 1st Battalion, 50th Infantry Division of Retired Vietnam War Veterans. He was a recipient of five Bronze Stars and three Purple Hearts.
