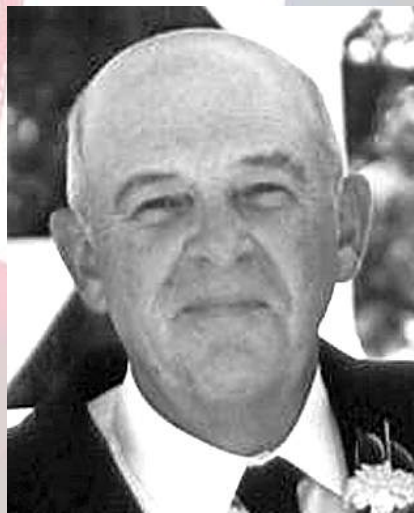


JAMES H. TISHLER
